Stakes Gr1 & **LIZARD ISLAND**, a fast finishing runner-up in the Caulfield Guineas Gr1.

### Singing Our Song

Launching a new stallion at Magic Millions always brings a special excitement and we can't wait for buyers to take their first look at the progeny of our gorgeous new boy Your Song.

Bred and raced by Gooree Stud as was the mighty Northern Meteor, Your Song retired lightly raced as an explosive Group I winning sprinter by champion sire Fastnet Rock.

He has let down into a magnificent stallion and has imparted his good looks and quality to his offspring.

The Magic Millions selection team have a fine reputation for honing in on the best first season sires and the fact he has 29 youngsters catalogued for sale speaks for itself.

Some of the obvious highlights include: a half-brother to stakes-winners The Voice and Royal Zulu Guard from good producer Ceol Na Sraide (IRE); first foal (colt) from stakes-winner Hoss Amor; a colt from Group I placed US stakes-winner Moon de French (USA); and first foal (filly) from stakes-winner Secret Status.

### From Strength to Strength

In the 2014/2015 Australian racing season Sebring emerged as a serious player with seven stakes -winners and a third place finish on the Australian General Sires List by earnings behind only Fastnet Rock and Exceed and Excel.

For a young stallion with only three crops racing to make such a huge impression against the established super sires stamped Sebring as a stallion

destined for greatness and everything that has happened since then has only served to enhance his status.

Sebring gets everything from brilliant juveniles to Derby winners, to weight-forage stars, his best progeny headed by \$7million earner Criterion and reigning Australian Horse of the Year Dissident, who has now retired to stud.

"We bred Dissident in partnership and he was foaled and raised here before being sold as a yearling in our draft at Magic Millions," Antony Thompson revealed.





"He's a Widden product through and through as his mother Diana's Secret, was also bred here and was sired by our former high class shuttler Anabaa.

"We take a great deal of pride and satisfaction in the achievements of the horses we produce and Dissident has set the benchmark very high as a five-time Group I winner."

The Sebring progeny are set to star at the Gold Coast in January and already two of his Magic Millions sold offspring have come out and won with exciting juvenile fillies The Last Kiss and Candika, both scoring on debut at Doomben for the Steven O'Dea stable.

Sebring has an exceptional offering with 50 entries including six that will be presented by Widden Stud.

They are: a filly bred on the same cross as Dissident being from stakes-winning Anabaa (USA) mare Marchelle Belle; a colt from stakes-winner Peach Tree; the half-sister to stakes-winner Runway Star from Intuit; a colt from Group III winner Valentine Miss; a colt from stakes-placed Fast Talker from the family of Golden Slipper winner Crystal Lily; and a filly from Polska, a daughter of Group I winner La Volta

### Stratum Star Keeps His Sire on Top

A Golden Slipper winning sire bought from the Magic Millions Sale ring in 2004, Stratum hit the heights early in his stud career with Golden Slipper winner Crystal Lily and the winners have kept on coming.

Leading Victorian trainer Darren Weir has become an avid fan thanks to the deeds of outstanding four year-old Stratum Star, a \$165,000 Magic Millions purchase that was bred and sold by Widden Stud.

A two time stakes-winner in Melbourne as a spring three year-old, Stratum Star blossomed this preparation to win the Group I MRC Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes and Group III MRC David Jones Cup as well as finishing third in the Group I MRC Toorak Handicap.

With earnings now approaching \$800,000, Stratum Star just keeps getting better and better.

Stratum is rarely without a good two year-old and the Lloyd Kennewell trained gelding Bullion Wolf has put himself in the picture for a Magic Millions 2YO Classic start with stylish victories at his only two starts in Adelaide during the spring.

Stratum has 16 entries for the Gold Coast including the full brother to his brilliant Group III winning son Va Pensiero and a half-sister to Group III winners Bliss Street and Jade Marauder from top producer Jade Diva.

#### How long have you been with Widden?

4 years ago I came to Widden to experience the sale circuit for just 6 months,......I still appear to be missing my passport!

### The most rewarding experience you have had as yearling manager?

Following Stratum Star through all his success has been pretty rewarding. He came out of the first big draft I prepared for Widden, and he was a difficult horse to manage. He was such an excited type of horse and so eager to learn. He had an infectious personality.

# Give us a couple of your favourite Widden yearlings you have prepared during your time?

Tawteen and Thurlow always had a bit of class about them, nothing was ever an issue, always ate up, worked well, no injuries very straight forward fillies. Vanburgh was my go to yearling for young rookie strappers to learn things on. He taught a lot of first timers how to parade, put a roller on, lunge etc and acted like a true gentleman. Lizard Island is another stand out. Huge personality, very much like his sire. He lived in the first box as you walk through in to the second barn where people would leave there jackets, sweaters and things hanging and he would pull them through the mesh, rip them into shreds then fire the pieces over the door.

### What is it about Widden bred horses enjoying such great success on the racetrack?

It's the attention to detail you see each foal receive from the moment they're born to the day they leave the farm. You never know if you are preparing the next future Stratum Star, Vanbrugh or Dissident.

# Brilliant Group One winner YOUR SONG has his first yearlings on offer in 2016. How are his progeny measuring up?

I have been impressed with the first lot of Your Song yearlings that have came through the barn so far. They have proven to be pretty straight forward horses to prep so far this season. They are naturally very athletic and muscular with great coats on them, they all have a positive work ethic and a good appetite to match up. I will look forward to see a few of them make an early appearance on the race track.

### What is the best part about working at Widden?

The best part of working at Widden for me is seeing the yearlings grow and graduate through the sale ring onto the race track with such great success. I get such a kick out of going to the races and seeing one of "our babies" fly past the winning post. So much time and planning and attention to detail goes into each individual that you just never know who is going to be the next champion.



### Lastly, a tip for a fast one in this year's Magic Millions draft?

I love the MAGHERB X YOUR SONG filly, she's all power with just the right amount of attitude. She always moves with so much balance and grace. And the I'M MARY TOO X CHARGE FORWARD colt never fails to impress me, he's quite the "pocket rocket"

### Star Witness Leads the Way

Just as good at three as he was at two, brilliant colt Star Witness has taken rapid strides this year in his burgeoning stud career with a slew of winners propelling him to the top of the Australian Second Season Sires List by winners.

20 winners and counting – the Star Witness stock have been racing up a storm with stakes performers Well Sprung and Kimberley Star leading the charge, while in South Africa, Mella Maria and Lineker have also made their presence felt.

Perhaps the most exciting winner of all has been the Hawkes Racing prepared two year-old colt Star Turn, who scored a commanding three length win in the \$150,000 ATC Pierro Plate in October.

The most expensive yearling sired by Star Witness in 2015 when fetching \$400,000 at Magic Millions, this Widden Stud bred and sold youngster looks like he might be another good one for well-known Sydney owner Alan Bell.

Star Witness has 19 entries for Magic Millions, eight of them to be offered by Widden Stud including: the first foal (colt) of Group III winner Dinkum Diamond; a three-quarter brother-in-blood to Star Turn from Hilton Head, a daughter of Group III winner Golden Delicious; and the first foal (filly) of Group I placed stakes-winner Ladys Angel.

### Nicconi Finds Success

The path to stud success for dual Group I winning sprinter Nicconi has been more one of a slow burn, rather than a meteoric rise, but make no mistake his winners are doing the talking as we move through the current season

Nicconi is leading the Australian Third Season Sire's List by winners from a stellar grouping that includes I Am Invincible and Medaglia D'Oro (USA).

His 40 plus winners include three stakes-winners in Concealer, Ayers Rock and Exclusive Lass and while many of his offspring seem to benefit from maturity, his first three juvenile runners this spring have all been winners!

The savvy yearling buyer will find great value in the Nicconi youngsters on offer at the Gold Coast and there are eight to choose from.
